- The following items were discussed:
 - Minutes from the previous meeting were discussed and they were approved. They were also approved by email by all SCC members.
 - Digital Citizenship Plan of Action form to School Performance and Digital Citizenship Week – February 6-10 was the Digital Citizenship Week for the District. Kids are informed about the internet safety rules at school. We discussed the possibility to send internet safety rules and different handouts to the parents. – See Digital Citizenship attachment.
 - Comprehensive School Improvement Plan & Land Trust Plan – Mr. Nalwalker gave a detailed presentation on CSIP and Land Trust Plan. Before the meeting, he met with the Building Leadership Team in preparation of the CSIP and Land Trust Plan. The teachers are committed to the idea of providing structured planning days this coming year. While we will keep the same number of Power Hour Instructional Aides they suggested to provide three additional planning days for intentional backwards planning from the standard

to assessment to instruction for teachers (see attachment Midvalley CSIP 2016).

- Land Trust—Increased funds
 - Why more prep time for aides is needed – Mr. Nalwalker addressed the situation with the time allocated currently for prep time for the school aides. They are in need for more time to prepare for the week. We discussed this and suggested to allow them more time to plan on Mondays for the entire week but keep the current prep time. No decision was taken as we would like to get more input from the school aides, teachers and SCC members.
- School Technology Report – Principal Nalwalker gave a detailed report on the number of computers/tablets that each class and grade has access to for class. He also presented different platforms / apps / systems that the kids use while at school for math or reading, arts.
- Child Access Routing Plan –was submitted to the District by Principal Nalwalker and is similar with the one from last year.
- Cones - access to West side of the school - was not discussed as more time was spent on the CSIP and Land Trust Plan.
