Midvalley Elementary School Community Council was pleased to be able to spend \$ 50,233.50 of LAND Trust funds on Midvalley Junior Huskies for the 2019 - 20 school year. It was determined that funds should be spent on reading interventions, reading enrichment programs, and technology. To increase reading achievement, students were identified as performing below benchmark on Acadience testing. Students identified received daily intervention support from intervention assistants under the direction of the achievement coach. Most of the allocated School Land Trust funding was used to hire five assistants to provide reading and enrichment interventions. Additional funds as indicated in our plan, were used to purchase iPADs and covers to be used in K-2 grades. The Midvalley School Community Council uses our LAND Trust Plan resources as a crucial component of our student achievement. The excellent faculty of the school uses these resources to support students to reach their full academic potential.
