Review current TSSP and Land Trust/Review School Data and next TSI 90 Day Plan (due November 30 to District Administration) We don't actually sign off on anything just information for us to know.

-At the Board Meeting Land Trust Goal was approved to change from 80% to 60%

Pathways of Progress for ALL students

-Starting a new support called Impact Teams based on student and teacher efficacy. All Grades involved but 1st grade and 3rd grade teams are piloting leading it in their teams. Sounds like a great program, each standard over time will get a rubric and steps for each child to be able to see their growth and see their end goals. This allows them to see their own personal strengths. The program focuses on each child's own growth and learning.

-Resource Teacher has developed a virtual classroom for students on Mastery Connect, reaching out to collect better data for her students. Then can be shared with the students' general education teacher. The goal is increased learning and communication.

-Talked about 8 or less is great, regarding attendance and it really seems to be helping the students. They remind them in Morning meetings. Also feel between the morning meetings and the positive welcomes from the teachers noticing their students are missing less school and telling them how much they missed them. Or greeting them, and etc. Working with families to understand home lives and what they need.

-Brainstorming an electronic way to send home things to parents of what they are currently working on for example empathy in Second Step. Making that common language in everyday classroom, but would be nice if the parents to understand what the school is working on and work on it at the house. The newsletter now goes home in paper form. Positive reinforcement. Overall going really well.

-Very pleased with the first 90 days!

District Safety Report Discussion:

-Re-visited Kindergarten parking lot issues, really school has done all that they can. The problem will be fixed when new building is done.

-The cross walk in the back, concerned about kids waiting to long for their parents. Who is responsible for those children at that time? Technically not school property? How to make sure kids aren't forgotten, especially with the cold starting to come. Principal will check on those students and see what can be done to reach out to families.

-The back doors in the back on inside days making sure somewhere is their to let the children in. Principal will work with teachers to assigne student council to monitor and open doors for students who come after first bell on inside days.

-The concern is mainly about the outside of the school and how to make sure children are safe while being picked up and dropped off, but the new bulding drop off will resolve most or all of the issues from the problems in the past.

-Talked about DIR-S app and why it was created and how it is being use for drills and communication for emergencies, if needed. Parents in attendance feel the school so very safe.

-With the construction workers been vey safe and respectful that this is a school. They make sure everything they are aware of the time to make sure not to block traffic and keep it safe. Never smell smoke, for instance.
